



Adult Day Care Re-Opening MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21

Dear Family and Friends,

Thank you for keeping Eliza Bryant Village in your thoughts and prayers as we continue to navigate challenges resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. We remain committed to providing the highest quality of care possible and ensuring the safety and comfort of every participant. We hope that you and your families are healthy and safe.

Four long months have passed since adult daycares were mandated to temporarily shut down to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Ohio Governor DeWine recently announced that adult daycare centers could begin to re-open starting Monday, September 21, 2020, and we hope that we will see you and your loved one very soon! There are new guidelines and restrictions that we must abide by to re-open. Our latest safety rules and a consent form are included with this mailing. Masks or face shields are required. Please review the material in advance of your return to help us plan and prepare for your safe and enjoyable return!

Our skilled nursing facility is accepting new admissions and is still restricted to only essential personnel entering the building. Outdoor visitation is underway, and scheduling appointments ahead of time is required. Our Elder Justice Center is accepting admissions, and our Independent, affordable housing program is accepting applications.

We will re-open using cohorts, gathering participants together as a group who will eat and participate in activities together. This is being done to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and help with any future needed contact tracing. If a COVID-19 case among participants is confirmed, all related cohort participants and their caregivers will be notified via a phone call from staff.

We will also be providing COVID-19 tests to program participants regularly, as this is required for us to re-open. Families will be notified via phone call of their loved one's test results from a Village staff member. Additionally, all Village staff continues to be tested regularly following state requirements.

Your understanding, patience, and cooperation during this process are much appreciated, as we work together to ensure that everyone is safe during this pandemic. Please contact us with any questions or concerns.

We hope you continue to stay safe and hopeful. We are so excited to see you soon.
