Dear Family and Friends,

This letter is to inform you that Eliza Bryant Village has re-opened for all visitations. As of June 18th, Governor Mike DeWine and Stephanie McCloud, Director of the Ohio Department of Health, have rescinded all restrictions that prohibited visitations in nursing homes to prevent the spread of contagious or infectious diseases. There is no longer a need to schedule visits.

We will continue to practice the established guidelines to prevent COVID-19. When entering the facility, you must:

- Sanitize your hands upon entry
- Wear a mask and goggles or face shield
- Have your temperature taken
- Complete the COVID-19 Signs and Symptoms Sheet

We ask that you continue to practice the CDC recommendations for preventing the spread of germs, at minimum, as listed below:

- If you are sick or not feeling well, please stay home
- Wear a mask and goggles or face shield
- Practice social distancing, as much as possible
- Use hand sanitizer placed throughout our facility
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. Sanitize your hands.

You will continue to have an opportunity to **visit with your loved ones using IPad, FaceTime and phone calls**. Thank you for your help in safeguarding the health of our staff and residents.
