Dear Family and Friends,

We are happy to announce that the time has come for us to begin re-opening up for visitations. Eliza Bryant Village is excited to begin welcoming you back inside, safely, starting Monday, November 1, 2021. Visits are scheduled on Monday, Wednesdays, and Fridays, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and again from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Visitations are scheduled for 30 minutes at this time. **To schedule your visit, please contact our Visitor Coordinator at (216) 658-8838.**

We will continue to abide by Ohio Governor Mike DeWine's safety protocols to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19. The following guidelines have been established for the safety of our residents, staff and visitors:

FACILITY PROTOCOLS

1. Designated area for visits. Entrance will be through the door located on the patio.
2. Will provide a mask, if needed.
3. Screen each visitor using COVID-19 symptom checklist.
4. Take temperatures prior to visit.
5. Transport residents to the visiting area.
6. Monitor visits to ensure adherence to time allotted and distancing protocol.
7. Clean areas upon completion of each visit.

VISITOR GUIDELINES

1. Visits must be scheduled.
2. There will be no more than 2 visitors per resident.
3. Duration of each visit will be for 30 minutes.
4. Each visitor must wear a mask and use hand sanitizer that will be available at the visitation site.
5. Each visitor must maintain the 6ft social distancing.
6. No pets will be allowed.

At this time, Eliza Bryant Village does not have confirmed COVID-19 cases in our skilled nursing facility. Should that change, Eliza Bryant Village reserves the right to cancel visitation for the safety of residents, staff, visitors and staff will call families in advance to reschedule.

During times that personal visits cannot occur, you will continue to have opportunity to visit with your loved ones using iPad, FaceTime and phone calls.

Please understand that these protocols and guidelines are in place to have a safe and effective opening. Any adjustments will be made based upon the assessment of the facility's ability to open. Your understanding, patience and cooperation during this process are greatly appreciated as we work together to ensure that everyone is safe during this pandemic.
